Thank you for entering the Hurstbourne 5 Multi-Terrain Race. Your race number is enclosed. Please pin it to the front of your running top.

2024 will see the fifteenth running of this event. For those of you that have taken part in previous years, thank you for your continued support in helping us raise over £44,000 for local charities. For those who have not taken part before, I'm sure you will find the course challenging, but I also hope that you enjoy the scenery of the North Wessex Downs. The race begins with a steep ascent before flattening out in woodland, with an "undulating" final mile! # Schedule & Restrictions

Main Race starts at 11am. Please assemble at 10:50. Minimum age on race day is 15. Competitors under the age of 18 must have approval from a parent or guardian. Unfortunately, the course is not suitable for wheelchairs, bicycles, pushchairs or prams, owing to the hilly and uneven terrain. The layout of the course also prohibits participation by walkers or runners with dogs. Under UKA rules, headphones are not permitted.

2K fun run starts at 11:05am (please assemble after main race has started) – No pushchairs please. Children under the age of 6 must be accompanied by an adult.

### Parking:

Owing to unprecedented levels of rainfall this winter, the usual car park is unavailable. The race organisers are looking at different options for free parking which we hope will be as convenient. Please keep an eye out for an email or Facebook post with updated parking instructions. We do recommend car sharing where possible this can be done when signing up through racesignup.co.uk or via the Hurstbourne 5 Facebook page. We do suggest allowing extra time for parking this year.

Please do not park on Church Street or Stoke Road, as this could delay access for emergency services

> South on the A34 for approx. 8 miles, then take Wash Common exit. Follow A343 West through Highelere, then after approx. 7 miles enter Hurstbourne Tarrant, Turn left before the George & Dragon pub, towards Stoke. The race start is 200 yards on


the right.

From M3 J9, take A34 North towards Newbury until the Wash Common exit, then

follow directions above.

From Andover, take A343 towards Newbury. After approx. 5 miles, enter Hurstbourne Tarrant and turn right at the George & Dragon pub, then follow directions
